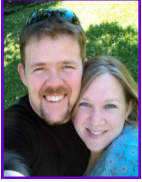

### Missional Shift #2: From Growing Into Service To Growing Through Service

A couple of weeks ago (Jan. 9) I wrote about how missional churches are focused on people development instead of program development. I wrote then about some spiritual practices we should use when we gather together. In order for us to connect what we hear in a sermon with what we know, we need to talk about it. Our purpose for gathering together isn't just to receive some new information. For us to make sense of what we are hearing and doing together we need time and space to breathe. We need to hear each other and talk a bit about what is going on outside the walls of this building. Our time together is meant for relationship building as well as information sharing. This is why we do adult class the way we do.

Worship is not just something we do on a Sunday morning from 9:45 am until 11:00 am or so. Just like a compass points to magnetic north, worship is a believer's tendency to be oriented God-ward. We point toward God all week long, everywhere we go. Everything you do has the potential to be worship. When you fill your car with gas, that can be an opportunity to worship. How? Is there someone there you can help at the gas station? You can help the guy that works at the gas station by picking up trash. This brings us to the second shift in missional practices

Service in the name of Jesus Christ is not a 'graduate level' spiritual practice. You don't arrive at service after years of getting all your junk straightened out. We wouldn't say this, but we behave like our spiritual walk begins with being baptized into the death of Jesus Christ and then we are supposed to spend a few years (even decades) getting our stuff worked out. Once we have sorted out our issues and are cleaned up a bit, then we are ready to get involved in a service project: raking leaves from 11am – 2pm on Saturday October 6th. But this isn't the way Jesus did it.

Jesus sent out the disciples in Luke 10 long before they were 'cleaned up.' They weren't ready but he sent them out anyway. Jesus knew that the best way to learn is to serve. Nothing puts your issues into perspective faster than meeting people with issues that are way worse than yours. We learn by doing.

That is why it has been our desire at Tintern that everyone have a meaningful outlet for service in the name of Jesus Christ. All of us should seek out (and not stop looking until we find) an opportunity to serve others in the name of Jesus.

- Carry a neighbour's mail from the mailbox out by the road to their door in icy weather.
- Drive your kid's classmate to school or hockey practice.
- Shovel your neighbour's driveway while they are at work.
- Visit someone who can't get out during the winter.

When they ask you why you did this you can say, "I am a disciple of Jesus and being a follower of Jesus means serving others."

Whether you are a brand new Christian or you have been a believer for fifty years, we want everyone to have a healthy, safe, age appropriate way to serve. Being a disciple means being a learner and in the first century there were no trade schools. You learned to be a carpenter by working at carpentry next to another carpenter. We learn to be disciples of Jesus, in part, by serving with Jesus, in the name of Jesus.

As we will talk about in our sermon today and in our adult class, being a Christian doesn't just include some service every once in a while. It "is" service.
